

## WHITE WINE

### **Roos Estate, Chenin Blanc, South Africa, 2018**

125ml: £3.75      175ml: £4.75      250ml: £5.95      Bottle: £17.45

*Crisp and vibrant with delicate citrus fruit flavours. This Chenin Blanc is a pale lemon colour in glass, it is crisp and vibrant on the palate with delicate citrus fruit flavours. Enjoy it with salads, poultry, lightly spiced dishes or on its own.*

### **Corte Fresca, Pinot Grigio, Italy, 2017**

*Cortefresca Pinot Grigio is an elegant, soft and nicely dry white wine. Has an excellent flinty, mineral depth.*

### **Paparuda, Sauvignon Blanc, Romania, 2017**

*Racy citrus notes dominate the palate of this crisp dry white. Grapefruit with touches of blackcurrant and guava dominates the palate leading through to a zesty, mouthwatering finish.*

### **Les Oliviers, Chardonnay, France, 2017**

*Smooth and refined with an underlying tang of freshness and supple, soft ripe fruit flavours on the palate. Finishes with a twist of melon and candied pineapple.*

### **Los Haroldos, Viognier, Argentina, 2017**

*Peach and apricot with some floral and aromatic notes. The palate is complex, fresh and unctuous with a lingering finish.*

### **Hidden Bay, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2017**

*Delicious flavour of gooseberry, well-balanced zesty citrus fruit, green apple and ripe melon mixed with subtle herbaceous mineral notes. Rich in flavour and complexity.*

### **Nuovo Quadro, Gavi di Gavi, Italy, 2016**

Bottle: £26.95

*An enticing nose of white peach and pear with hints of fresh lime and gooseberry. Fresh and zesty citrus notes and ripe peachy characters are balanced by crisp acidity and mineral notes leading to a textured, gently nutty, complex finish. Made with the Cortese grape.*

**Saint Clair, Pinot Gris, New Zealand, 2014**

Bottle: £28.45

*Aromas of freshly baked bread crust straight from the oven, with fragrant ripe pear, lead to fresh and juicy with flavours of baked pear crumble. The wine is finely structured, with a rich, silky mouthfeel and a dry finish.*

**Domaine G.Tassin, Sancerre, France, 2017**

*Dry, crisp and elegant with fresh gooseberry fruit dominating the senses. Unoaked, the palate is rich in fruit flavours and finishes with the right balance of texture and refreshing acidity.*

**Domaine De La Motte, Chablis, France, 2017**

Bottle: £36.95

*A classic Chablis from vines grown on the famous Kimmeridgian clay with nervy, mineral fruit but added depth from a small, around 10% addition of oak-aged wine into the blend. This is very typical of the Motte style and gives a richness and balance to the wine.*

**Cloudy Bay, Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2017**

Bottle: £44.95

*The nose is bright with aromas of kaffir lime and grapefruit. A generous palate reveals ripe citrus, stone fruit and lemongrass flavours balanced by crunchy acidity. Perhaps the hallmark of this vintage is its persistent finish rich with minerality.*

**ROSE WINE**

**Pacific Heights, Zinfandel Blush, USA, 2016**

*This sweet wine exhibits bright aromas of strawberry and watermelon on the palate. It is flavoursome and well-balanced with a refreshing mouth feel and a light crispness on its lingering finish.*

**Sacchetto, Pinot Grigio Blush, Italy, 2015**

*The appealing pale blush colour of this wine is obtained from the skins of the Pinot Grigio grapes which are pink in colour. A fresh and fruity wine with a delicate flavour and an off dry finish.*



## RED WINE

### **Roos Estate, Merlot, South Africa, 2018**

125ml: £3.75      175ml: £4.75      250ml: £5.95      Bottle: £17.45

*An elegant Merlot with blackcurrant and dark cherry fruit flavours but with a fine, graphite tannin structure showing depth and length. Enjoy it with red meat and rich pasta dishes or on its own.*

### **Paparuda, Pinot Noir, Romania, 2017**

125ml: £4.15      175ml: £5.15      250ml: £6.45      Bottle: £18.95

*Pale garnet in colour with aromas of violets, dried cherries and hints of tobacco. Juicy, light and berry filled on the palate with a velvety finish.*

### **Barton & Guestier, Cabernet Sauvignon, France, 2016**

*An intense nose of plum and blackcurrant, with delicate toasty notes; the palate is silky and long with plenty of red fruit and hints of vanilla.*

### **Soldiers Block, Shiraz, 2017**

125ml: £4.55      175ml: £5.55      250ml: £6.75      Bottle: £19.95

*Soft supple Victorian Shiraz, dangerously moreish by the glass. Lifted, aromatic and juicy on the nose with just a touch of naughty bacon fat. True to the varietal, the tiny proportion of Malbec in this blend gives a flowery perfume*

### **Mont Rocher, Carignan, France, 2015**

Bottle: £20.95

*Juicy and a beautiful cherry red colour. The nose shows an abundance of deep red berry fruit and hints of vanilla flavours. The palate is soft, full flavoured with a smooth easy drinking finish.*

### **False Bay, Pinotage, South Africa, 2012**

Bottle: £22.95

*Perfect Pinotage: bright, vibrant and juicy. Deep garnet colour. The nose includes intense fruit aromas, particularly black cherry and strawberries with hints of liquorice. The palate includes lovely wild fruit crumble flavours with a herbal note and a hint of chocolate supported by soft tannins.*

### **Cerro Anon, Crianza Rioja, Spain, 2014**

125ml: £4.95      175ml: £6.45      250ml: £7.95      Bottle: £23.95



*Intense dark red and ruby in colour. Initially fruity on the nose, followed by the spicy aromas created during the oak ageing process. Round and mellow in the mouth with a lovely, long finish.*

**Messeri, Negroamaro Primitivo, Italy, 2016**

Bottle: £24.45

*Intense ruby red colour with purple highlights. The bouquet is complex and rich with hints of ripe fruits and spices. Excellent body and structure.*

**Il Faggio, Montepulciano, Italy, 2015**

Bottle: £24.95

*A deep ruby red in colour, with lifted perfumes of dark fruits, plums and cherries and a hint of mocha. This wine has soft, ripe tannins and a delicious chocolate-cherry finish.*

**Los Haroldos, Malbec, Argentina, 2018**

Bottle: £25.95

*Ruby red in colour this has a soft and elegant aroma of plums and cherries. Flavours of fresh red fruits with a little spice and smooth tannins, a rounded persistent finish*

**Ondarre, Rioja Reserva, Spain, 2011**

Bottle: £29.75

*Leather and spice of a traditionally made Rioja enveloped in a smooth and textured palate. Delicious.*

**Terre Divine, Fleurie, France, 2014**

Bottle: £29.95

*A delicious feminine wine with strawberry and raspberry aromas complemented by a touch of spice. A pleasant, sweet and rounded finish.*

**Famille Quiot, Chateauneuf-du-pape, France, 2012**

Bottle: £34.95

*Deep crimson in colour with ripe dark berries and spices. Smooth and persistent with aromatic fullness. Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault grapes.*

**Sansilvestro, Barolo, Italy, 2014**

Bottle: £39.95

*San Silvestro Barolo 'Patres' 2013 is an intense, spicy, elegant Barolo from a fine vintage. Beautiful aromas of 'tar and roses' give onto an intense, elegant palate with impressive length of flavour.*

**Domaine Robert Gibourg, Gevrey-Chambertin, France, 2012**

Bottle: £49.95

*Lovely notes of fresh raspberries enhanced by fine oak with a good structure and depth of flavour through to a long and balanced finish with fine tannins.*

## SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

### **Prosecco Spumante 'Passaparola' DOC Italy**

*This classic from the north of Italy is a delicious sparkler with aromatic pear flavours on the nose followed by a crisp palate of succulent apple and pear. Crisp and delicate finish.*

### **Borgo Molino Motivo Rose Extra Dry Italy**

*Vibrant pink in colour with strawberry and raspberry fruits and a touch of rose petal. Light and fresh with persistent bubbles.*

### **Champagne Etienne Lefevre Grand Cru Carte Blanche NV Brut**

*Pale gold with traces of pink and a fabulous mixture of sensations (apples, pears, plums). Fresh, lively and smooth.*

### **Veuve Clicquot Brut NV Champagne**

*Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power, with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mousse.*

### **Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial NV Champagne**


*Perhaps the best known Champagne, the Brut Imperial from Moët embodies their house style: crisp and clean, this classic Champagne shows citrus aromas and hints of biscuity flavours. An excellent apéritif.*

### **Laurent Perrier Rose NV Champagne**

*This wonderful pink champagne is pale salmon in colour, with precise, crisp aromas of strawberries, redcurrants, raspberries and black cherries. It has fine bubbles with persistent mousse, and prominent flavours of soft red berry fruit, with a well defined wild cherry aspect. Long, rounded and supple on the finish.*

## **Dom Perignon '2009 Vintage' France**

*The first hints of fresh almond and harvest aromas immediately open up into preserved lemon and dried fruits, the whole rounded off by darker smoky and toasted qualities. The presence of the wine on the palate is immediately captivating. Paradoxically concentrated yet creamy, it is energetic and warm in the mouth, focusing on the fruit.*
